Learning outcomes: The student will gain knowledge about the organization and functioning of the EU judicial system, detailed knowledge of individual types of proceedings before the EU courts and skills in the field of legal writing, argumentation and the creation of court filings. In addition, a good knowledge of the procedures for the creation of EU jurisprudence will deepen the general knowledge and understanding of the EU legal system.
