



Information pursuant to Article 11(4) of the Study Regulations of Comenius University in Bratislava, Faculty of Law (for groups of all lecturers)

- I. Semester/academic year: *summer semester, 2022/2023*
- II. Study programme/degree/form: *law/II./full time*
- III. Course title: ***Public International Law 2 and International Criminal Law***
- IV. Scope of compulsory participation in educational activities
 - a) *Participation of students in seminars is compulsory. Students are obliged to follow the lectures.*
 - b) *If a student does not attend three seminars his/her absence is excused.*
 - c) *For fourth and fifth absence teacher may decide on substitution if the absence was caused by serious and objective reasons.*
 - d) *Sixth and following absence cannot be excused at all.*
- V. Conditions under which a student may make up absences from seminars:
The substitution under art. IV (c) may be in form as decides teacher including studying in presence of a teacher; examination from the topic which was discussed on missed seminary; writing of a paper and so on.
- VI. Specification of the method of assessment of learning outcomes, including specification of the method and conditions for the completion of the mid-term assessment:
 - a) *Mid-term assessment makes 40% of total evaluation.*
 - b) *Mid-term assessment consists of activity (10%) and written assignments (30%).*
 - c) *Final oral examination makes 60% of total evaluation.*
 - d) *Only a student that obtained at least 60% from mid-term assessment (that is 24% of total evaluation) may undertake final oral examination.*
 - e) *If a student failed to obtain at least 60% from mid-term assessment, he/she has to register for corrective mid-term assessment in form of a written examination during exam period. This will replace the mid-term assessment as such (will have weight of 40%) and will take place usually before the final oral examination.*
- VII. Dates of mid-term assessment, thematic headings of individual terms mid-term assessment.
 - a) *Written assignment will be due in the 10th week of the semester.*
 - b) *Activity will be assessed throughout the semester.*





- VIII. Information on alternative possibilities for fulfilling the conditions of mid-term evaluation, but which are not the total remedial term of the mid-term evaluation according to Article 13, paragraph 4 of the Faculty's Study Regulations:
Will not be set.
- IX. Information as to whether the achievement of the prescribed level of mid-term assessment or the prescribed level of compulsory participation in learning activities is a condition for passing the examination
- a) *If the student has six or more absences he/she will not be classified (mark "X").*
 - b) *If the student has four or five absences that are not excused he/she will not be classified (mark "X").*
 - c) *Student has to obtain at least 60% from mid-term assessment (that is 24% of total evaluation) for undertaking the final oral examination. In case of failing to obtain it he/she will be classified with mark "Fx."*
