- I. **Semester/academic year:** Winter, 2023/2024
- II. **Study programme/cycle/form:** Management and Law/first/full-time
- III. **Course title:** World Legal Systems
- IV. **Extent of the compulsory participation in educational activities**
- a) Student participation in seminars is mandatory.
 - b) If the student does not participate in three seminars, his/her absence is excused.
 - c) The fourth absence is replaced by a written submission.
- V. **Conditions under which a student may compensate absences from educational activities:**
- In the case of the fourth absences, the compensation consists of submitting a written assignment.
- VI. **Specification of the method of assessment of study results, including specification of the method and conditions for the completion of continuous evaluation retakes:**
- Continuous evaluation: 20%
Final oral exam: 80%
- VII. **Dates of the continuous evaluation and topics:**
- Continuous evaluation is realised in form of a written essay (2000 words) on a previously agreed topic. Deadline: 12 November 2023; Re-take: 3 December 2023
- VIII. **Information on alternative possibilities for fulfilling the conditions of the continuous evaluation, which does not, however, represent the overall continuous evaluation retakes according to Article 13, paragraph 4 of the Faculty's Study Regulations;**
- No alternatives.
- IX. **Information on whether the achievement of the prescribed level of continuous evaluation or the prescribed extent of compulsory participation in learning activities is a precondition for taking the final exam.**
- a) In case of non-participation in more than four seminars, the student is not evaluated for the course and cannot take part in the exam (unclassified - "X").
 - b) If the student does not substitute the fourth absence from the seminars, the student
