- IV. **Language:** English
- V. **The extent of compulsory participation in educational activities**
Students are informed that the conditions of participation in individual forms of teaching and the replacement of non-participation are covered by the Study Regulation: <https://www.flaw.uniba.sk/o-fakulte/legislativa-a-dokumenty/vnutorne-predpisy-a-opatrenia/zakladne-vnutorne-predpisy/studijny-poriadok>.
Students are highly recommended to participate in all in-class activities during the course.
- VI. **Conditions under which a student can make up for not attending seminars:**
Substitute performance for non-participation in the seminar over the number of absences stipulated by the Study Regulations is determined by the lecturer individually, taking into account the number and reasons for absences, usually in the form of a paper on a topic agreed with the student.
- VII. **Concretization of the method of evaluation of study results, including concretization of the method and conditions of passing the corrective terms of the continuous evaluation:**
The evaluation consists of two parts:

A. Active participation during the seminar

During the semester, the students shall prepare the presentations on the topics related to the seminars provided by the lecturer and be ready to discuss them with other





participants. The discussions will be conducted in the format of the research and practical conference/round table.

Students can get a maximum of 50 points = 50 percent for the active participation during the seminars.

B. Exam essay

The second part of the course evaluation is an essay written on one of the topics provided by the lecturer in advance.

Students register for the exam through the AIS system, the date chosen for them. The essay (minimum 1000, max 1500 words with footnotes) shall clearly outline the problem and provide scientifically proven solutions. During the exam, the students will be asked questions related to their essay and shall demonstrate the deep knowledge of the topic and the ability to use their knowledge and skills in theoretical research and practice.

Students can get for the exam a maximum 50 points = 50 percent of the total evaluation.

VIII. The final evaluation

The student can get a total of 100 points = 100 percent of the evaluation. The final evaluation (grade) will be determined as follows:

- A** = 91–100 %
- B** = 81 – 90 %
- C** = 73 – 80 %
- D** = 66 – 72 %
- E** = 60 – 65 %
- Fx** = 0 – 59,9 %

IX. Information whether the condition for taking the exam is the achievement of the prescribed level of continuous assessment or the prescribed scope of compulsory participation in educational activities

If the student does not replace the fourth (and next) non-participation in the seminars or does not prove a sufficient degree of self-study during the examination the student is not evaluated from the subject and cannot take the exam (it is unclassified - "X").
