- I. **Semester / academic year:** Summer semester, a.y. 2023/2024
- II. **Study program / degree / form:** law/I. degree and II. degree /daily
- III. **Course title:** **EU Environmental Law**
- IV. **Language:** **English**
- V. **The extent of compulsory participation in educational activities**
Students are informed that the Study Regulations of the Comenius University in Bratislava, Faculty of Law apply to the conditions of participation in individual forms of teaching and to compensation for non-participation.
Students are required to participate in seminars on Thursday 16:45 – 18:10 in room no. 4 in the old building.
- VI. **Conditions under which a student can make up for not attending seminars:**
The Department accepts 4 absences of non-participation in seminars, in such a way that the first 3 are accepted without excuse and the 4th non-participation must be replaced by the student. Compensation for non-participation in the seminar is determined by the teacher individually based on the student's request.
- VII. **Concretization of the method of evaluation of study results, including concretization of the method and conditions of passing the corrective terms of the continuous evaluation:**
The evaluation consists of two parts:
- A. Presentation**
The assessment consists in the preparation and presentation of the selected topic, or issues related to the subject. The subject of the assessment is the written part in the form of a report, the written part in the form of a presentation and a presentation in front of the class.





For a written, submitted and presented topic, students can receive a maximum of 50 points = 50 percent of the total evaluation.

Students will be notified of the number of points earned after the presentation. Students can get a maximum of 50 points = 50 percent of the total evaluation for the written and submitted essay.

B. Essay

During the semester, students are given the opportunity to choose one of the set topics (or they have the opportunity to propose their own topic) and their duty is to write an essay of a set length (usually 15 to 20 thousand characters). The range of topics is determined in accordance with the theses of the lectures and seminars.

Students can receive a maximum of 50 points = 50 percent of the total grade for the written and submitted essay.

Students will be informed of the number of points obtained after the essay has been submitted and assessed by the teacher.

C. The Final evaluation

The student can get a total of 100 points = 100 percent of the evaluation. The final evaluation (grade) will be determined as follows:

A = 91–100 %

B = 81–90 %

C = 73–80 %

D = 66–72 %

E = 60–65 %

Fx = 0–60 %

VIII. Information whether the condition for taking the exam is the achievement of the prescribed level of continuous assessment or the prescribed scope of compulsory participation in educational activities

A. Participation

If the student does not make up for the fourth (and subsequent) absences from the seminars, or does not demonstrate a sufficient level of self-study in the examination, the student is not evaluated for the subject and cannot take part in the examination (he is unclassified - "X").

B. Prescribed level of interim assessment

During the semester, a student can earn up to 100 points for an activity at seminars, while in accordance with Art. 11 par. 16 of the Study Regulations of the Comenius University in Bratislava, Faculty of Law, a student is assessed with the classification





level Fx if he does not even reach a level reaching 60% of the total highest possible level of fulfillment of the requirements for passing the course, which represents 60 points. A student who does not have the required number of points can take part in the subject exam within the dates listed in the AIS system.

IX. Additional information

- A. The course usually has its own team in the MS TEAMS application, where students will be added after the first seminar.
- B. It is necessary to prepare for the seminars and bring materials according to the teacher's guidelines
