- I. Semester/academic year: *Winter semester, 2023/2024*
- II. Study program/degree/form: *Law/ masters/ full-time*
- III. Course title: *Interpretation and Argumentation in Legal Practice*
- IV. Extent of compulsory participation in educational activities:
Maximum of 3 absences.
- V. Conditions under which a student can substitute for non-participation in seminars:
Acceptable two more absences. In case of more than 5 absences, the student will not be admitted to the evaluation (student will have to repeat the subject within the next teaching period). Conditions for replacement of 4th to 5th absence – according to agreement with the teacher.
- VI. Concretization of the method of evaluation of study results, including concretization of the method and conditions of passing the corrective terms of the mid-term evaluation:
Method of evaluation: 100 % continuous assessment during semester (40 % active participation in class, 40 % final essay or case study, 20 % final presentation)
- VII. Dates of the mid-term evaluation, thematic areas of individual dates of the mid-term evaluation:
*Topic for final essay will be announced on **10th semester week (20.11.2023)**.
Thematic areas: according to the information sheet of the course.*
- VIII. Information on alternative possibilities of meeting the conditions of the mid-term evaluation, which, however, are not the overall corrective/remedial date of the mid-term evaluation according to Art. 13 par. 4 of the Study Regulations of the Faculty:
Substitute dates for submitting of the final essay and final presentation will be scheduled only for students who did not attend the announced date and who proved that they were unable to participate in this form of examination for objective and relevant reasons.





- IX. Information whether the condition for taking the examination is the achievement of the prescribed level of mid-term evaluation or the prescribed scope of compulsory participation in educational activities:

The course does not have a final exam. The minimum number of points obtained from the continuous assessment for successful completion of the course is 60 %.
