



**Information according to Art. 11 par. 4 of the Study Regulations
Comenius University Bratislava, Faculty of Law**

- I. Semester/academic year: *Summer semester, 2023/2024*
- II. Study program/degree/form: *Law and Management/bachelor/full-time*
- III. Course title: *Theory of Law II. (Basics of Political Science and International Law)
(for all lecturers)*
- IV. Extent of compulsory participation in educational activities:
Maximum of three absences.
- V. Conditions under which a student can substitute for non-participation in seminars:
Acceptable one more absence. In case of more than four absences, the student will not be admitted to the final evaluation (student will have to repeat the subject within the next teaching period). Conditions for replacement of 4th absence – according to agreement with the teacher.
- VI. Concretization of the method of evaluation of study results, including concretization of the method and conditions of passing the corrective terms of the mid-term evaluation:
Mid-term evaluation:
- *25 % of evaluation will be an essay writing (10 points);*
 - *25 % (10 points) will be a written test;*
- Final evaluation:*
- *50% will be oral exam (20 points).*
- VII. Dates of the mid-term evaluation, thematic areas of individual dates of the mid-term evaluation:

Mid-term evaluation:

*Students have to submit an essay by **March 20, 2024** on a topic agreed with a designated teacher. The essay requirements will be communicated to students, and they may get a 25% of evaluation (10 points) for the essay.*

*There will be a written test in **7th semester week (03.04.2024)** covering the material discussed so far. Expected thematic areas of the test: State and law (theory, concepts, relationship); Basic features of the state, form of state; Power, authority*





and law; Citizen and state; Law and Politics.

Students will be able to receive an additional 25% of the evaluation for the test (10 points)

Final evaluation:

There will be an oral exam during the examination period of the summer semester, which will focus on selected aspects of international law that will be covered during the teaching part of the semester.

Students will be able to get final 50% of the evaluation (20 points)

Classification scale: (A / 1 = 91-100%; B / 1.5 = 81-90%; C / 2 = 73-80%; D / 2.5 = 66-72%; E: 60-65%, Fx: 0-59%)

- VIII. Information on alternative possibilities of meeting the conditions of the mid-term evaluation, which, however, are not the overall corrective/remedial date of the mid-term evaluation according to Art. 13 par. 4 of the Study Regulations of the Faculty:

Substitute mid-term evaluation dates (written test) will be scheduled only for students who did not attend the regular mid-term evaluation date and who proved that they were unable to participate in this form of examination for objective and relevant reasons.

- IX. Information whether the condition for taking the examination is the achievement of the prescribed level of mid-term evaluation or the prescribed scope of compulsory participation in educational activities:

The condition for taking the final examination (oral exam) is to obtain at least 60 % of points from the mid-term evaluation (i.e. 12 points), as well as to meet the necessary mandatory participation in seminars.
