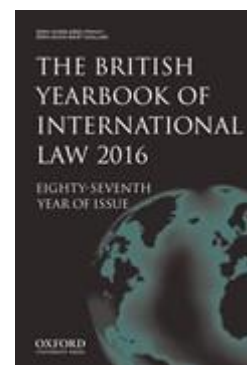

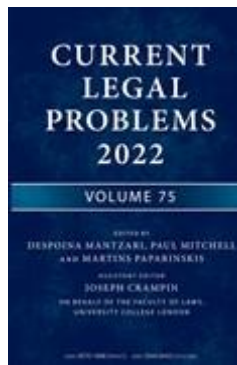
European Journal of International Law
