



**Information according to art. 11 par. 4 Study
regulations of Comenius University in Bratislava,
Faculty of Law
(for all pedagogical staff)**

- I. Semester/academic year: *Summer semester, 2023/2024*
- II. Study program/degree/form: *Management and law/full-time*
- III. Course: *Roman law 2*
- IV. **Range of obligatory attendance at educational activities:**
- a) *Attendance at seminars is obligatory. The students are obliged to attend lectures in person.*
 - b) *If a student does not attend 3 seminars, the absence is excused according to valid Study regulations.*
 - c) *It is not necessary to validate reasons for fourth absence at seminars.*
 - d) *In case of fourth and any subsequent absence art. 4 par. 18 of valid Study regulations of the Faculty of Law, UK, will be applied.*
- V. **Concretization of evaluation of study results:**
- a) *Mid-term test (MT) via MOODLE app in the week 29. April – 3. May 2024.*
 - b) *Reparatory in-term exam via MOODLE and their date will be known by the date realisation of the attempt.*
 - c) *Final (oral) exam – student draws two questions. The examiner will take into consideration the result of the in-term exam in the rate of 80:20.*
- VI. **Themes for in-term evaluation:**
- a) *Roman litigation, Law of obligations – obligations in general, general featured of Roman contracts, Consensual contracts (sale, letting and hiring), verbal contracts, contracts re (mutuum, commodatum, depositum), contracts litteris.*
- VII. The student has three opportunities to absolve the Mid-term test (proper term + first + second reparatory term). The proper and first reparatory term take place during the teaching part of semester, the other will be in exam period.
- VIII. Information about subsidiary options of fulfilling the conditions of MT, which are not overall reparatory term for CE according to art. 13 par. 4 of the Study regulations of the faculty:
- Subsidiary terms for the MT will only be assigned to those students, which did not attend the proper term and provide the proof of objective and serious reasons that prevented them from attending such form of exam.*





IX. Information, if achieving prescribed level of MT or attendance is necessary to perform the final (oral) exam

- a) *In case a student is absent at more than four seminars (if not substituted), the student will not be evaluated and cannot attend the exam (is unclassified – „X“).*
- b) *A student cannot attend the exam without successful MT; a successful MT is if the student acquires a grade A, B, C, D, or E. The examiner will take into account the grade achieved in CE account while conducting the final exam in the range of 20% of the overall grade (see above).*

Evaluation: FX = did not pass. The evaluation of the MT for the course of Roman Law is as follows:

10 points = A (excellent)

9 points = B (very good)

8 points = C (good)

7 points = D (satisfactory)

6 points = E (sufficient)

5-0 points = FX (insufficient = did not pass).
